s (As part of your medical education, you are <u>required</u> to complete the Heartcode BLS/CPR training. This skills training includes an online portion and in-person training by Hackensack Meridian Health Occupational Health Team. You will be <i>assigned</i> to attend in-person training during HDIO and will receive your assigned date and time before HDIO begins.
	Prior to the in-person session, you'll need to complete the online portion of Heartcode BLS through the American Heart Association (AHA). To participate in the Heartcode BLS on-site skills training, you must

present a certificate of completion. An auto-generated email from the eLearning platform will be sent to

you before HDIO to complete the BLS Heartcode Online. This online portion takes about an hour and a half to complete and is due **Monday**, **July 11th**, **2022**.

Please note that even if you have recent BLS/CPR training from a previous institution, you are required to complete the HMH training course.

Fit testing is a requirement for the Hackensack Meridian Health network, and it will be done during your in-person BLS/CPR Skills training. You must completely fill out our <u>OSHA form</u> by Friday, July 8, 2022 (prior to the start of HDIO).

Health Insurance

Hackensack Meridian School of Medicine requires all students to either <u>enroll or waive</u> in the student health insurance plan each year. The 2022-2023 health insurance policy runs from 7/1/2022 to 6/30/2023. Students with comparable, comprehensive coverage can waive coverage no later than <u>July 29, 2022</u>. Any student that fails to waive by that date will automatically be enrolled. There are no exceptions. **All students must be covered by health insurance**.
