<a href="#">National Health Service Corps Loan Repayment Program</a>	Licensed primary care clinicians in eligible disciplines can receive loan repayment assistance through the NHSC Loan Repayment Program (NHSC LRP).	December
<a href="#">National Health Service Corps Scholarship</a>	Students pursuing primary care health professions training may be eligible to apply to the National Health Service Corps Scholarship Program (NHSC SP).	December
<a href="#">Centers for Disease Control and Prevention</a>	EIS officers are selected from among highly qualified applicants who are drawn to public health service and interested in practicing applied epidemiology.	May
<a href="#">Pisacano Leadership Foundation</a>	Open to rising 4th year medical students.	May
<a href="#">US Dept. of Veteran Affairs Loan Repayment Program</a>	The Specialty Education Loan Repayment Program (SELRP) provides financial assistance to physicians in the form of a loan repayment to recent graduates of an accredited medical or osteopathic school, and are currently enrolled or matched to a residency identified as a shortage by the U.S. Department of Veterans Affairs (VA).	
<a href="#">Health Professions Scholarship Program</a>	The Health Professions Scholarship Program (HPSP) offers two-, three- and four-year military scholarships that can help cover civilian medical school tuition, pay for fee, and provide a monthly living stipend. The length of these scholarships can vary by Service branch.
